

## Scholarship Program

The Central Soccer League provides a platform for competitive, Regional level soccer for youth in the Central Region of Ontario. We are a member-driven organization that promotes the drive for excellence both on and off the field of play. As such, we would like to recognize those individuals who best exemplify the spirit of fair play, who possess the ability to balance both academic and athletic success, and who display leadership skills in the pursuit of excellence.

The girls award is named the Carolyn Jones Memorial Award in memory of a long standing member of our soccer community. A past member of the CGSL league executive and an individual who possessed all of these qualities of fair play and the consistent pursuit of excellence. The boys award is named the Herb Schranz Memorial Award in memory of our past Discipline Chair. Herb was a member of the CSL executive who knew his way around Ontario Soccer Rules and Procedures. Herb was always for available to provide sound advice and guidance to members of the Executive.

The League will present two scholarship awards annually (one for the girls division and one for the boys division), for an amount of \$2000.00 each, to a player/candidate who qualify based on the following selection criteria;

- 1. A student enrolled in Grade 12 (or equivalent) and graduating during the current season.
- 2. A student who maintains a minimum average of 75% during both Grade 12 semesters.
- 3. A candidate that has played in the Central Soccer League/Central Girls Soccer League for a minimum of 3 years.
- 4. A candidate that has best exemplified the aforementioned qualities of fair play, academic and athletic excellence, and leadership skills both on and off the field.
- 5. A candidate that has been accepted (or will be by the end of the current season) at a recognized <u>Canadian</u> College or University.
- 6. A candidate that has done community service work with their respective Clubs/ Districts or Leagues (reference letter required).

If the player/candidate fulfills these qualifications, their respective applications will be reviewed by an executive committee panel and the award recipient will be chosen. The awards will be presented at the conclusion of the U18 Cup Final each season. This award program will be reviewed annually and the CSL executive reserves the right to make any necessary adjustments based on budgetary considerations. The deadline for submission is July 7 of each season.

### Guidelines for Scholarship Program

#### Program:

- 1. There will be two (2) scholarships awarded, not to exceed a cumulative total of Four Thousand Dollars per season (\$4000.00).
- 2. Each scholarship will not exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00).

#### General Eligibility:

- 7. A student enrolled in Grade 12 (or equivalent) and graduating during the current season.
- 8. A student who maintains a minimum average of 75% during both Grade 12 semesters.
- 9. A candidate that has played in the Central Soccer League/Central Girls Soccer League for a minimum of 3 years.
- 10. A candidate that has best exemplified the aforementioned qualities of fair play, academic and athletic excellence, and leadership skills both on and off the field.
- 11. A candidate that has been accepted (or will be by the end of the current season) at a recognized College or University.
- 12. A candidate that has done community service work with their respective Clubs/Districts or Leagues (reference letter required).
- 13. Submission Deadline is July 7 of each season.

### Scholarship Payment:

Scholarship award will be paid by cheque, in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars CDN. (\$2000.00) and will be presented during the U18 Division Cup Tournament.
