7. PLAYER IDENTIFICATION

| <p>A. Team officials must carry Ontario Soccer player books/cards to all games.</p> <p>B. The inspection of OS player books/cards by the opposing team is mandatory prior to the start of the game and must not delay the scheduled kick-off.</p> <p>C. Failure to produce the OS player books/cards will result in forfeiture of the game and fine as per 4 D.</p> <p>D. Only players for whom OS books/cards are made available for inspection may have their names entered on the game sheet and be eligible to play.</p> <p>E. Once a game has been started, team officials forfeit the right to investigate OS player books/cards, excluding late player arrivals only, whose OS books/cards must be checked prior to entering the field of play and must refer to Rights and Responsibilities 21 should they wish to initiate a protest.</p> <p>F. Failure to inspect the OS player books/cards will result in a fine. (See Appendix A)</p> <p>G. Any player arriving after the start of the second half, is not eligible to play in that particular game.</p> <p>H. Only original Ontario Soccer books/cards will be acceptable. No photocopies or digital copies allowed.</p> <p>I. Violations of Section 7 could result in forfeiture of game and fine (See Appendix A).</p> |

OS Player Books/Cards are expected to be checked 15 minutes prior to the scheduled kick off. Books are checked against the player. If a team has any concerns, they may request to look at the game sheet..

A grace period of twenty minutes will be allowed for ALL CSL Games in the event that a team has less than seven players at the appointed kick-off time. This will also apply to those that do not have the required number of players with OS Player Books/Cards.

If books/cards are checked prior to the referee showing up, advise the referee that they have been checked.

NOTE: BE SURE THE REFEREE CHECKS OFF THE APPROPRIATE SECTION ON THE GAME SHEET IF THE CARDS ARE CHECKED.

LATE PLAYERS:

Any player arriving late must have his OS book/card checked by the opposing team official before entering the field of play. If the opposing team official refuses to check the card, the player is eligible to play.

No books/cards will be checked after the whistle to start the second half. Any player arriving after this point is ineligible to play.

If OS Player Books/Cards are not checked prior to the game, team officials forfeit the right to check the books/cards at any time during the game and players arriving late are eligible to play at anytime.
